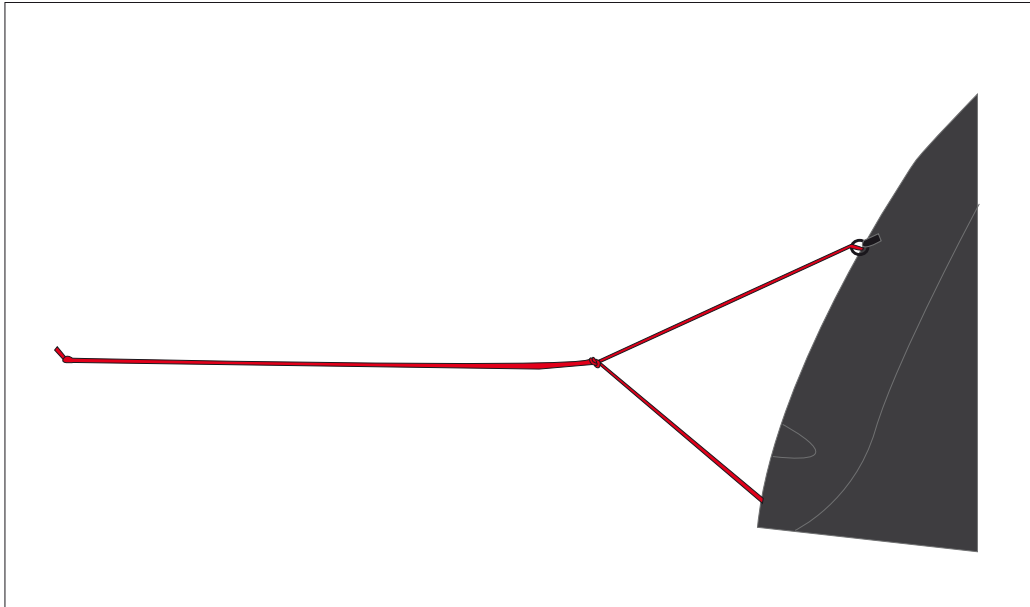
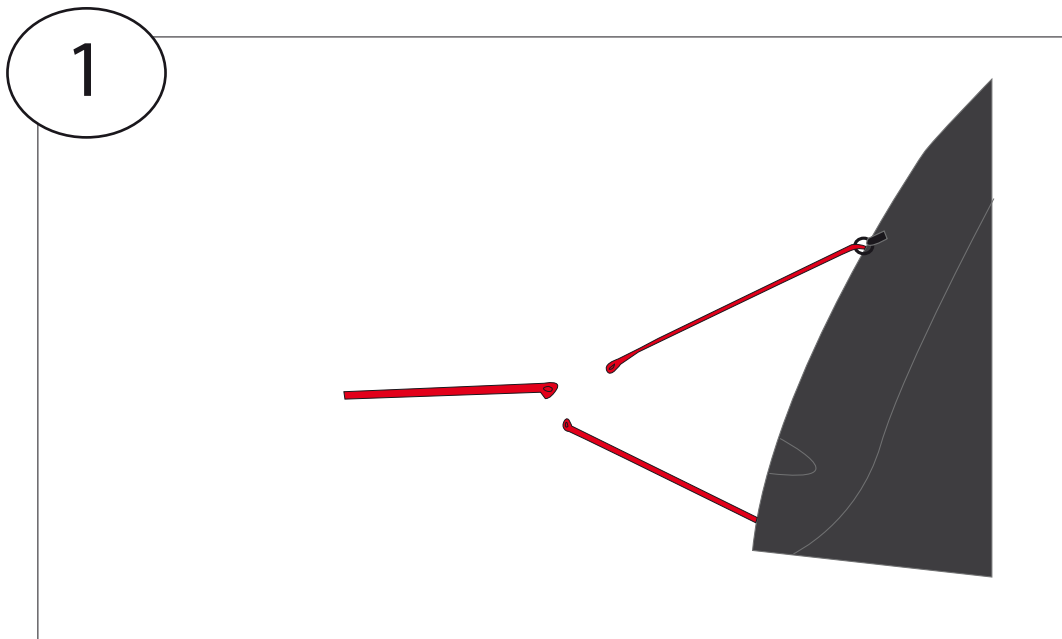


North Kiteboarding - Fuse Pigtail Optimizing Instructions

On the Fuse 10 m2 some riders may prefer more reactive bar input and lower steering forces. This can easily be achieved by shortening one leg of the back line pigtails. The back leg of the Back-Pigtail-Bridal should be shortened by around 25-30 mm with a simple figure eight knot as explained in the following three easy steps:

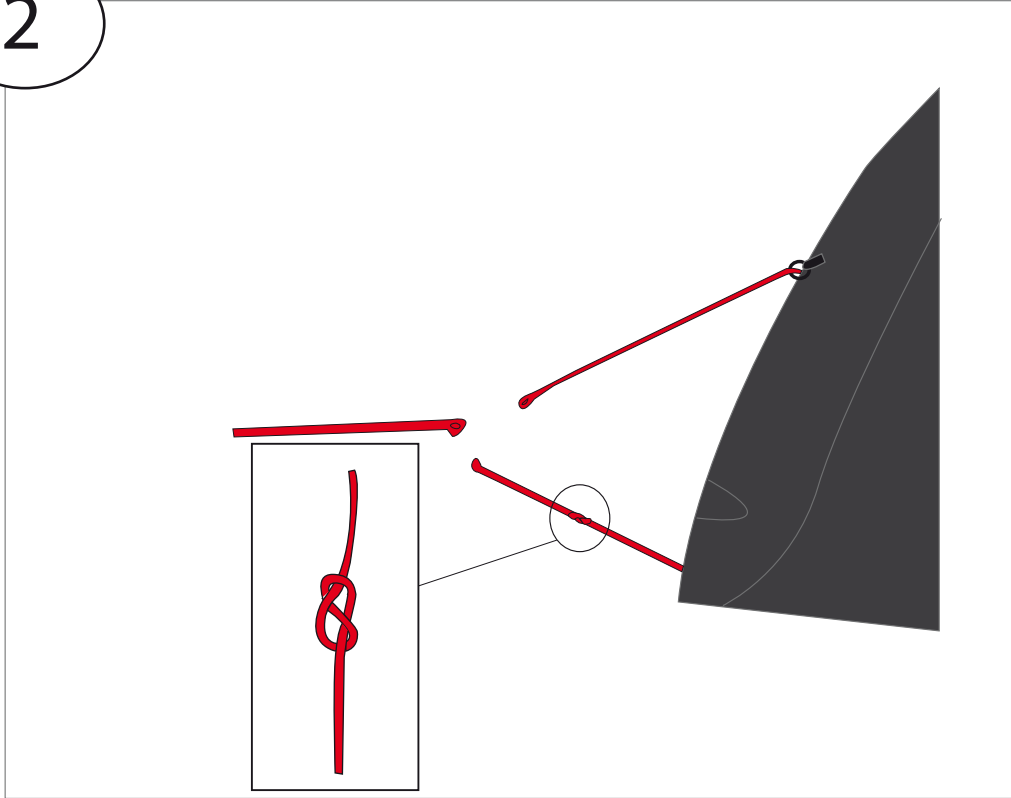


Back Pigtail Bridals



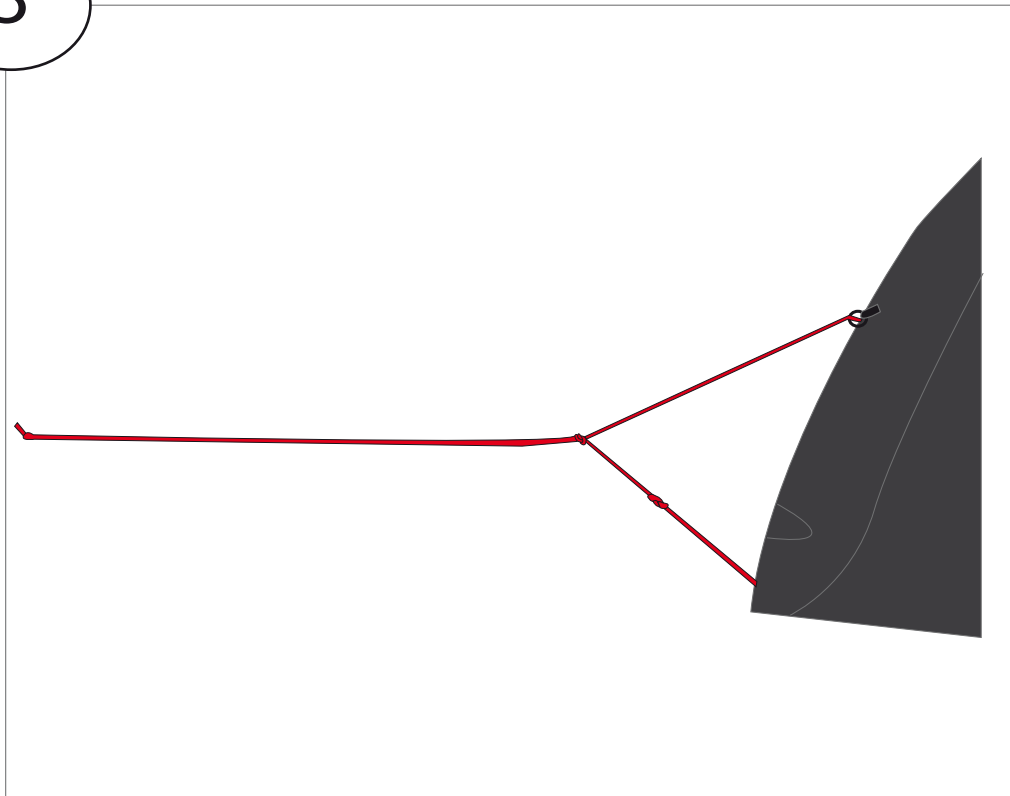
Step 1: Untie the point where the three lines of the back line pigtail-bridal converge.

Step 2: Tie a figure eight knot in the back leg (line closest to the kite's wingtip) of the bridal as shown in the illustration.

Step 3: Finally knot the three lines together as they were in the beginning
